Weekly Update from the Pastor

PENTECOST

Coming to the end of the Easter Season, this weekend we celebrate Pentecost Sunday. On Pentecost we rejoice in the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and on the Church. The Gifts of the Holy Spirit help us as we seek to live life as intentional followers of Jesus Christ in his Church. These gifts of wisdom, understanding, fortitude, knowledge/or the ability to judge correctly, piety/reverence, and fear of being separated from God, all help us on our journey of faith. May we, like those before us, be witnesses to the power of the Holy Spirit as we live faithful lives of service.

FAITH FORMATION AT SAINT AUGUSTINE - SAINT FRANCIS XAVIER

Last Sunday, Ms. Natalia Parra, who serves as the Director of Faith Formation and Pastoral Associate spoke at Mass as part of requesting a greater participation in forming adults and children in the Catholic Faith.

Ms. Parra shared that over the last year, following the COVID closures, enrollment was up 25% and happily that the retention of students grades 1-4 was an encouraging 66% with class attendance at 82% per session, with the retention in grades 5-8 at 64%. The generosity of parents, volunteer catechists and classroom assistants is ensuring that we move ahead in forming children in the Catholic faith that guides us and gives us hope. We all see many more children at Mass as part of their formation.

In the same way, we are grateful to the witness of those praying with us each weekend at Mass. It gives us great encouragement for the future plans that will be revealed in the upcoming year. Last weekend, \$3,764.00 was donated in the second collections to directly assist our efforts in forming children and adults. Thank you for your generous response, and for those who came forward to discern assisting with Faith Formation.

INCOME/EXPENSE REPORT FOR MARCH AND APRIL

The report below demonstrates the income from weekly collections and rental income at Saint Francis Xavier. The expenses noted in major repair and maintenance for Saint Augustine reflect electrical repairs on the Church to replace rotted wires for safe use of the building. The large numbers at Saint Francis Xavier reflect the current phase of addressing deferred maintenance at the former rectory/Parish Office and additional repairs to Saint Francis Xavier's former school. As I noted at Masses, the condition of the school was so poor that the original budget for repairs, years before I began my Pastorate, was \$6,000,000, of which we were only able to borrow \$4M through Diocesan loans. Ongoing maintenance of the building will ensure the lease with the Department of Education will continue to bring much needed income to the Parish. We continue to work to develop the buildings serving the parish, so that we can continue to bring the Gospel to Park Slope and beyond. Gratitude is extended to those who support our works in Jesus' name. May the Holy Spirit continue to fill your heart with peace and hope,
